

History Major Requirements: (39 semester hours) Students seeking a major in History must complete 39 semester hours within the 124 semester hour History curriculum, which include History 1010, 1020, 2010, 2020, 3990, and 18 semester hours of advanced American and European/non-American history courses, nine of which must be in one field and nine in the other. Students must also complete Social Studies 1030 (Social Sciences Seminar) and Social Studies 4020 Capstone course.

History Minor Requirements: (21 semester hours) History 1010, 1020, 2010, 2020 and nine hours of advanced history.

Creole Studies Minor Requirements: (18 semester hours) History 3040; Anthropology 4050; English 4770 or 4873; Sociology 4080; 3 hours from Music 2000, Art 3600, Theatre 4260 or Dance 4500; 3 hours from Art 4030, History 4080, Anthropology 4060, or English 3850.
